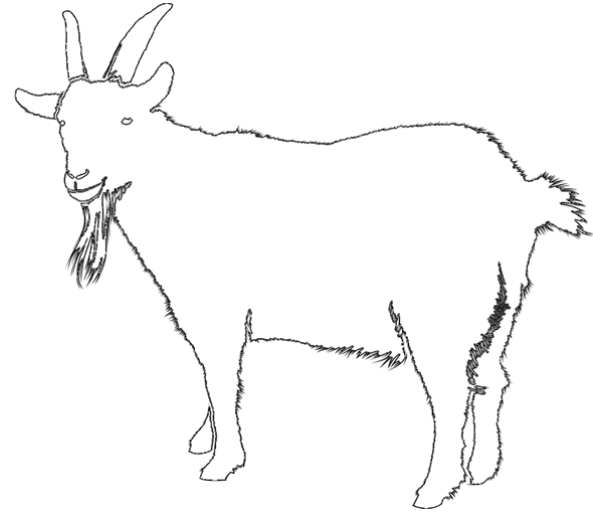
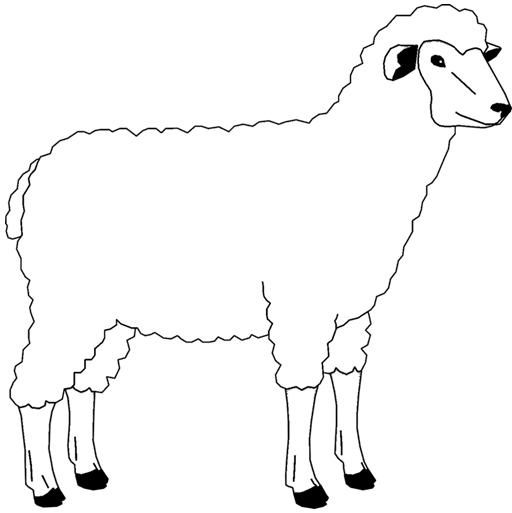


The Sheep And The Goats
